## **DISABILITY FESTIVAL TO BE HOSTED ONLINE**

The Free State Department of Sport, Arts, Culture and Recreation (DSACR) in partnership with Free State Performing Arts and Transport for People with Disabilities will stage the 2020 Disability Arts Festival which is organized to celebrate people with disabilities by creating a platform for them to showcase their talents. The Disability Arts Festival will be staged under the theme: **#PutYourselfInMyShoes**. This festival will serve as a platform to celebrate people with disabilities and will also be used to raise awareness about the protection of rights of persons with disabilities. It will also coincide with Disability Month and the International Day of Persons with Disabilities that is observed on 3 December around the world.

Due to the advent of COVID-19 global health pandemic, this year's edition of the festival will be streamed live on Departmental social media platforms. It is also an opportunity to reflect on progress we have made in addressing the challenges faced by persons with disabilities as we commemorate 26 years of democracy.
