2022 LIBRARY WEEK

South African Library Week (SALW) is an annual celebration highlighting the valuable role libraries and librarians contribute to communities. It also aims to promote the use and support of libraries. According to the Library and Information Association of South Africa (LIASA), SALW will be celebrated from the 14-20 March 2022 with the theme "*Relmagine! RePurpose! ReDiscover ...Libraries!*"

During 2022 Library Week, the entire library and information services sector has been implored to *Relmagine* and *RePurpose* Libraries so that the communities they serve will *ReDiscover* and celebrate them again after many months of not using our libraries to their full potential as a result of the COVID-19 lockdown regulations.
