DSACR HANDS OVER SPORT EQUIPMENT AND PLAYING ATTIRE TO PREVIOUSLY DISADVANTAGED SCHOOLS IN THE PROVINCE

The Free State Department of Sport, Arts, Culture and Recreation will handover Sport Equipment and Playing Attire to 75 previously disadvantaged Schools in the province.

The identification of the 75 previously disadvantaged schools was done in consultation with Department of Education based on proportional division and schools that reside within Quintile 1 -3, close proximity and schools currently participating in schools’ sport to facilitate the league system. The identified beneficiaries for 2022 are as follows:

- 12 Schools from Fezile Dabi District
- 15 Schools from Lejweleputswa District
- 20 Schools from Mangaung Metro
- 24 Schools from Thabo Mofutsanyana District
- 04 Schools from Xhariep District

Each school submitted a completed needs analysis of required sport equipment and/or attire to the department by August 2022. The costs culminated to a total procurement value of R 1 336 723.55

Since the inception of this programme in 2006, the department has supported over 900 public schools in the province with the provision of sport equipment and playing attire to enable a conducive environment for district, provincial and national school sport championships.
